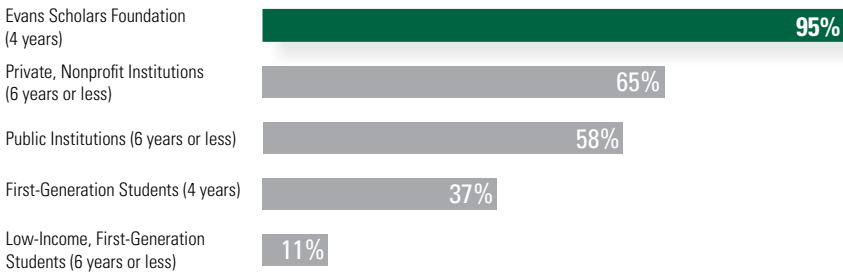

Evans Scholars graduate at a rate of **95%**, significantly higher than national averages for the student populations the Program serves. After graduation, Evans Scholars are well-prepared to build successful careers.

Percentage of Scholars who are first-generation college students

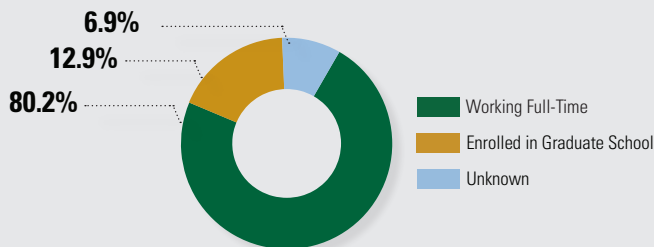

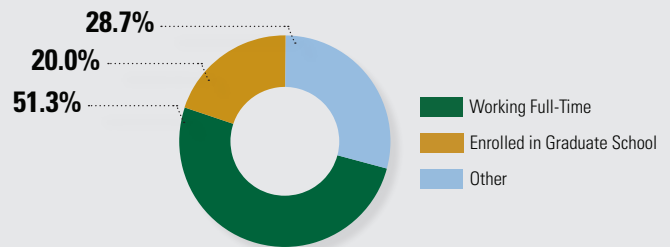
Status Six Months After Graduation²
